Proposed changes to the Behaviour Policy

As the school continues to develop and improve, we are continually looking to raise expectations and aspirations of our students. In order to achieve this, we have reviewed and amended our Behaviour Policy and some information for parents/carers is attached.

Our focus will be on ensuring basic expectations are met and teaching and learning is not interrupted, for example by;

- low level disruption,
- lack of required equipment,
- lateness to lesson or school,
- failure to complete homework

Full details of the policy will be posted on our website next week. The important change I wish you to note is the establishment of a regular after school detention as part of the sanctions section of the policy.


If you wish to discuss these changes senior colleagues and myself will be available to meet with parents/carers at 5.30pm on Monday 13th February in the Auditorium.
