

**Accelerated reader analysis and impact**

**Year 8 September 2016**

On entry this cohort had 60% of students that were 10 months or more below their chronological reading age, this has now reduced to 14%. The PP cohort previously had 65% that were 10 months or more below their chronological reading age and this has reduced to 3%.

Currently 27% (65 students) have a reading age on or above their chronological age in this cohort.

38% (35 students) of PP students have a reading age on or above their chronological age.

This is an improvement of 5% since entry for the full cohort and 24% for PP students since entry.

Accelerated reader lessons still take place with Year 8 once each week in order to improve the reading ages further.

**Year 7 September 2016**

On entry 22% (54 students) have a reading age on or above their chronological age in this cohort.

14% (13 students) of PP students have a reading age on or above their chronological age.

The cohort has 59% (144 students) that were 10 months or more below their chronological reading age on entry and 67% of PP (62 students).

Accelerated reader is now taking place once each week to improve student reading ages.
