Netherwood uniform – reminder of expectations

Firstly, I would like to thank the vast majority of you for sending your son/daughter to school every day in the correct uniform. On the whole pupils at Netherwood Academy are smartly dressed and take pride in their appearance.

I wanted to give you some prior warning that from **Monday 29th April** onwards we will be reinforcing our uniform policy and making sure ALL pupils meet the required expectation. Below is a reminder of what that expectation is, you can also see this on our website, which includes photos. Please can you ensure your son/daughter comes to school in full, correct uniform.

Daily expectations


- Blazer and tie
- Plain black school shoes – waterproof and leather/leather look. Black trainers or canvas shoes are NOT ALLOWED
- Shirts – white cotton and tucked in at all times
- Trousers and skirts – plain black tailored trousers; plain black Netherwood skirt which must be KNEE LENGTH.
 - **No jeans, leggings, jeggings or skinny fit trousers are allowed**
- Jumpers – plain v-neck with the Netherwood logo

Any pupil who turns up with incorrect uniform will be asked to change it and borrow our stock where possible, otherwise they will be placed in isolation. We may also have to call you to bring the correct uniform for them.

May I also take this opportunity to remind parents/carers that mobile phones are not permitted to be seen or heard in the school building from 8:20 until the end of the day. If we see phones or hear them, we will confiscate them and return at the end of the day as indicated in our policy.
